

FOR YOUR SAFETY

The following is provided to ensure you are aware of basic requirements for the safe operation of all recreational vehicles. Your sales or rental person, to verify you understand the information and operation, will address each of the following points.

1. Always utilize the factory installed seat belt restraints while vehicle is in motion.
2. Beds, overhead bunks, sofa, dinette or chairs not equipped with seat belts or factory restraint system are not safe to occupy while vehicle is in motion.
3. Shut off furnace, water heater, refrigerator, stove and generator as well as any other open flame object, while refueling gasoline, diesel or propane.
4. Secure any loose objects prior to movement of vehicle.
5. Always use a lookout when backing up vehicles even if equipped with rear monitor.
6. Be aware of the total height of your vehicle, including roof mounted accessories, and verify clearance of any low object before attempting to pass beneath.
7. Lock all door locks when vehicle is in motion.
8. Exhaust ports for furnace and water heater are extremely hot when in use. Contact with these ports will cause burn injury.
9. Emergency window exits are not to be opened except for emergency. Danger of falling from vehicle exists with emergency exit open. Observe and warn all children of danger.
10. Showers and tubs are slippery when wet and not for utilization while coach is in motion.
11. Roof Tops are dangerous at all times and extreme caution must be observed if accessing roof for any reason.
12. Never attempt to change vehicle tires. Always contact a professional tire facility qualified for this operation.
13. Open stairwells and other objects are potential hazards during darkness. Be aware of their location and use minimal lighting if available.
14. Awning operation can cause finger and hand injury. Know the operation of your awning before attempting to use it.
15. Discontinue travel during high wind conditions.
